



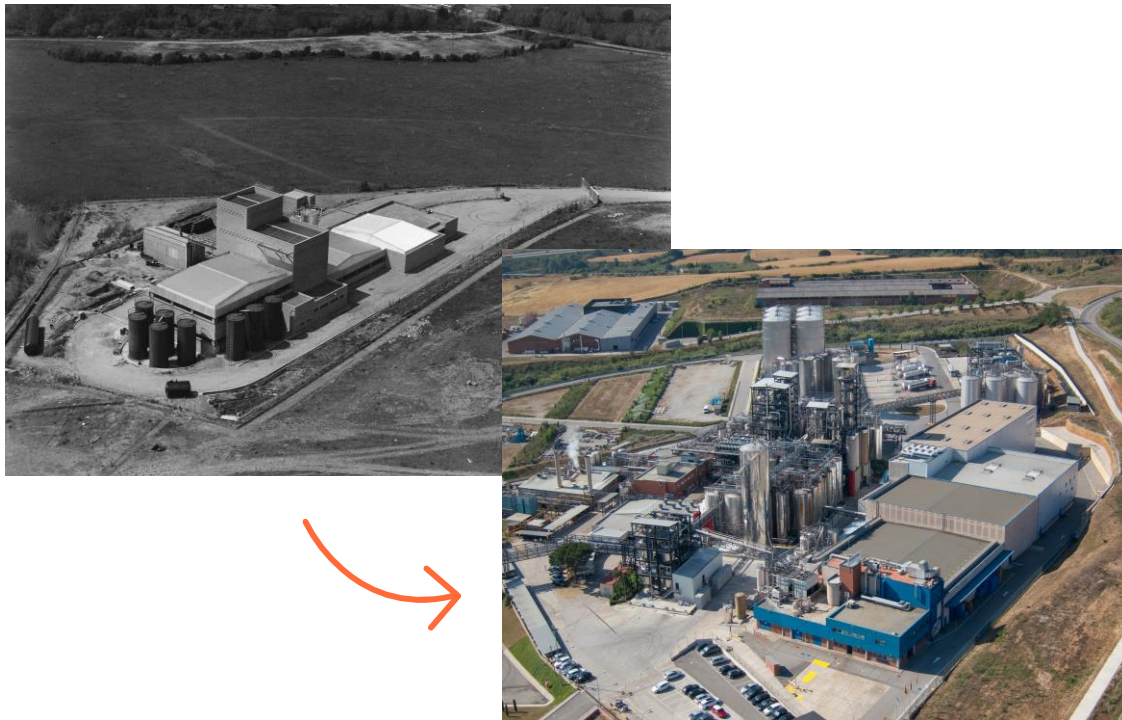

Our history

1973: Start of the refining activity (animal fats).

1982: Refining and hydrogenation of vegetable fats begins and first physical refinery.

1990: Liberalization of the vegetable oils and fats sector with the termination of import quotas and export tariffs of European Union countries.

2000: Construction of a cogeneration plant (5MW). Deodorization and discoloration capacity is doubled.

2010: Opening of the Huelva refinery.

2017: LIPSA exceeds the 600,000mt in sales of refined oils and exports more than 170,000tn

2019: Transformation of Huelva plant and new SBEO extraction plant in Barcelona.

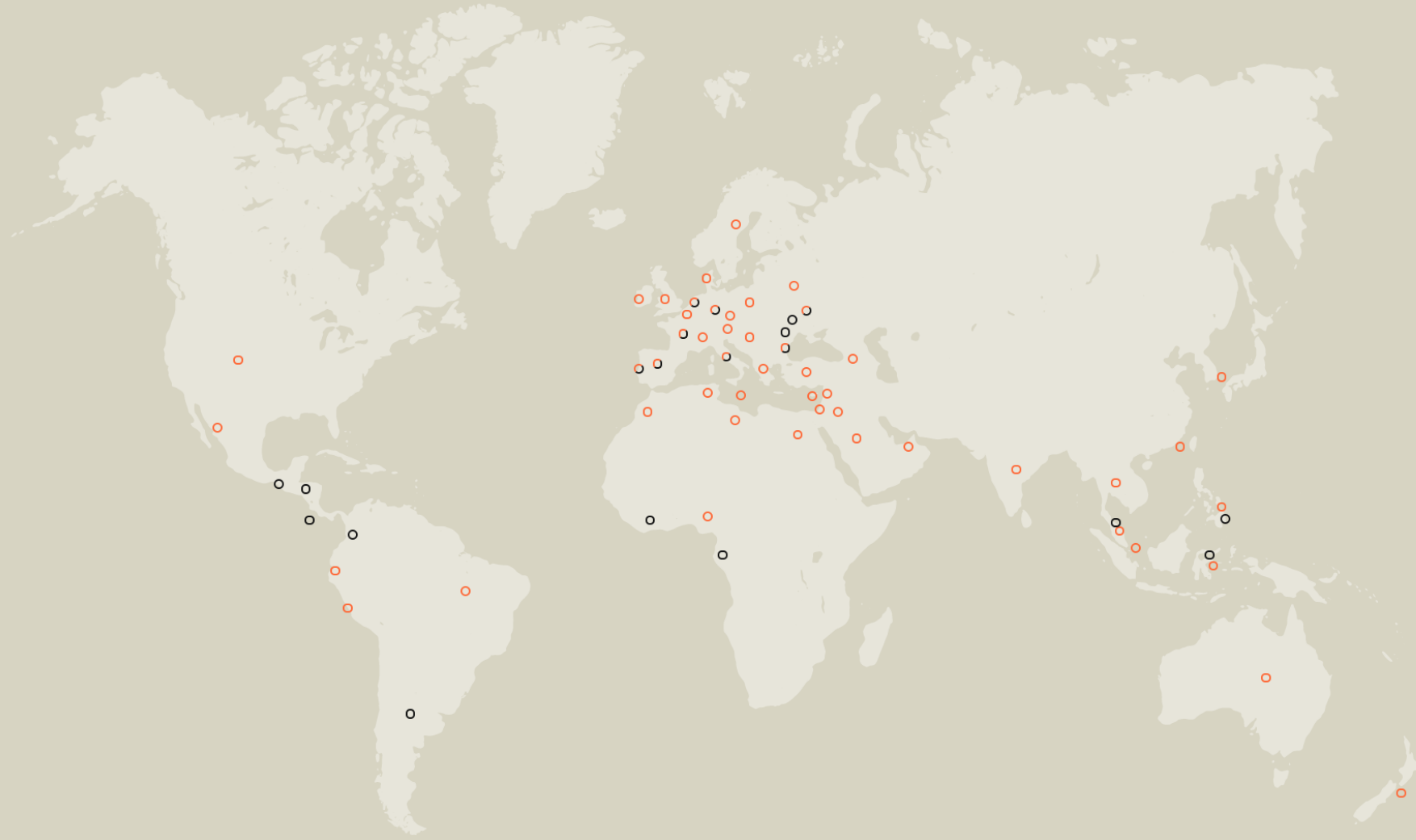

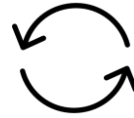

We work with our clients, suppliers and partners, promoting change throughout the supply chain. We believe that it is crucial to work together on an industry level to build sustainable supply chains.

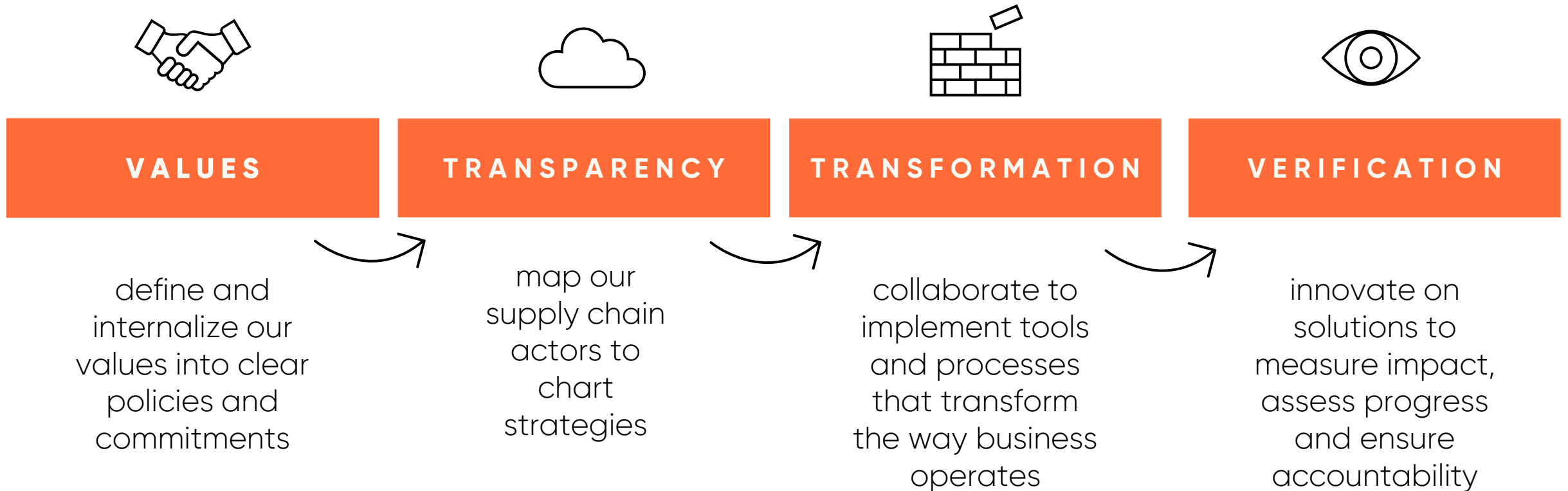
